Days where the candidate from distant corners of the state used to wait eagerly for information days together and spend lots of money and time have become history.

WORK CARRIED OUT IN KPSC COMPUTER CENTER

Computer center carries out the Electronic Data Processing work as per the needs of the Commission.

Providing information sought under RTI which are received from various branches.

5. Legal matters:

Preparation of Various statements of New Cases, Pending Cases, Disposed Cases in respect of KAT, High Court, Supreme Courts and Civil Courts as per the needs of the Legal Cell.

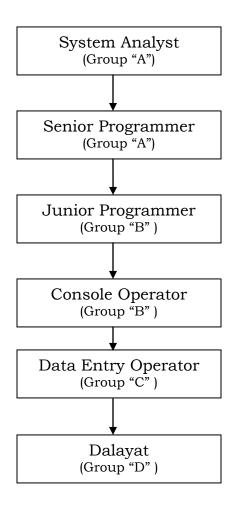
6. Website:
