No: FEE 54 FTC 90, Bangalore, dated: 4th August, 2003

Whereas the draft of the Karnataka Forest Department Services (Recrujtment) Rules, 2003 was published as required by sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Karnataka State Civil Services Act,1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990) in Notification No. FEE 54 FTC 90, dated 10th June, 2003 in part IV-A of the Karnataka Gazette Extra-ordinary dated 16th June, 2003 inviting objections and suggestions from all persons likely to be affected thereby within fifteen days from the date of its publication in the official Gazette.

And whereas the said Gazette was made available to the public on 16th June, 2003.

And whereas the objections and suggestions received within the period specified above, have been considered by the Government.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 read with section 8 of the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990), the Government of Karnataka hereby makes the following rules, namely,

RULES

- 1. Title and commencement :- (1) These rules may be called the Kamataka Forest Department Services (Recruitment) Rules, 2003.
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. The category of post, scale of pay, method of recruitment and minimum qualification: (1) In supersession of Notification No. AHFF 9 PEG 85 (PF), dated 29th June 1987 published in Karnataka Gazette dt.23.7.1987 in respect of each category of posts specified in column (2) of the Schedule-I, their number and scales of pay shall be as specified correspondingly in columns (3), (4), (5) and (6) thereof.
- (2) The method of recruitment and the minimum qualifications, if any, in respect of the categories of post specified in column (2) of the Schedule-II shall be as specified in the corresponding entries in columns (3) and (4) thereof.
- 3. Repeal and savings: The Karnataka Forest Department Services (Recruitment) Rules, 1987 are hereby repealed:

Provided that such repeal shall not affect,-

- (i) the previous operation of the said rules or any thing duly done or any action taken thereunder; or
- (ii) any right or obligation accrued or incurred thereunder.
